

## IMPORTANT NOTICE

As we prepare for the merger with Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union (APFCU), there are several items you need to be aware of.

We will begin to transition your records to APFCU at the close of business on May 31, 2011. The credit union will close at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 31st. At that time no other transactions will be allowed, which means the following services will be disabled at 4:00 p.m.

- ATM Services
- VISA Debit Card Services
- TellerLine (Telephone Audio Response)
- NewsLine (Home Banking)
- Bank of Hawaii Services
  - Encashment - cashing your share draft
  - Deposit - deposits made at BOH
- Stop using your share drafts

By 7:30 a.m. on June 1st, your account should be moved over to APFCU and you may begin enjoying the benefits of their services and branches. By then, you should have received your new cards or checks (if applicable) and may begin using them.

## MORE IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Please do not write any more share drafts after May 31, 2011. If you have a Share Draft Account, you will receive a starter kit to begin writing drafts on your new account beginning June 1, 2011.
- If you have any automatic payments from your Share Draft Account or VISA Debit Card, you will need to change the authorizations to reflect the new credit union, routing and account numbers. This also goes for those with Direct Deposit. You will need to contact your HR or Payroll Department to make the change. Changes should be effective June 1, 2011.
- Although both credit unions offer similar types of loans, they are different. Due to regulatory compliance with federal laws, we do not have enough time between the disbursement and required notification of any change of terms. Therefore, during the month of May, Media Hawaii FCU will not be offering loans. If you need the loan right away and can not wait until June 1, 2011, you may go to an APFCU Branch and apply for a loan there. You will be required to open an account with them according to their terms and conditions.
- Please review and keep your statements. When the credit union merges the records, history of your transactions will not transfer over. Please keep your statement and review the activity and transactions, especially the last statement from Media Hawaii FCU and the first one from APFCU.
- If you presently have a VISA Platinum or Classic Credit Card, you may continue to use them until March 2012. If your card expires before that time, you will receive a new card with the same account number but with APFCU's logo.
